

First Lieutenant Wilbur J. Vinson, Ol289347, 323rd Inf, for heroism in the Tennessee Maneuver Area on 6 May, 1943. First Lieutenant Vinson, at or about 2100, 6 May, 1943, with utter disregard of his own safety, with difficulty succeeded in running down and mounting a run-away \(\frac{1}{4}\)-ton truck as it was gaining speed in a downhill dash through heavy underbrush and small trees and steered the truck into a tree, thereby receiving minor personal injuries. The actions of Lieutenant Vinson saved many enlisted men from serious injury and possible death as the driverless truck was traversing an area in which enlisted men were sleeping. This courageous action was in accord with the highest tradition of the military service. Entered Military service from North Carolina.
